Homeschooling

- ❖ As the name implies, it is the schooling of learners by parents or guardians. However, parents may seek the help of tutors or do cooperative learning with other parents.
- ❖ DepEd curriculum k-12 is the core curriculum.
- ❖ Parents make a study plan that suits their family lifestyle, child's learning style.
- ❖ Parents make quizzes, long tests to be validated by Kids World
- ❖ Make periodic reports to Kids World.

Home based Online Learning

- For parents who out of necessity opt to home school their child but have no time to follow up, make schedules, and quizzes.
- Common delivery of lessons:
 - synchronous (with a teacher present online 2x/week)
 - asynchronous (lessons posted in google platform)
- Learning materials: Books, modules, videos, links to specific resources
- Students will take scheduled quizzes and exams.
- Students who wish to do Face to Face MAPEH, may register to do so. Additional fees will be collected.

HYBRID (ONLINE/ FACE TO FACE)

combination

- For learners who are ready to do face-to-face: 3x a week in school; 2x a week online. MAPEH IN SCHOOL. Progressing to full in-school attendance.
- Learning Materials: Books, modules, videos, links to specific resources.
- Parents may request for additional one-on-one tutorials, however this is not included in the payment package.

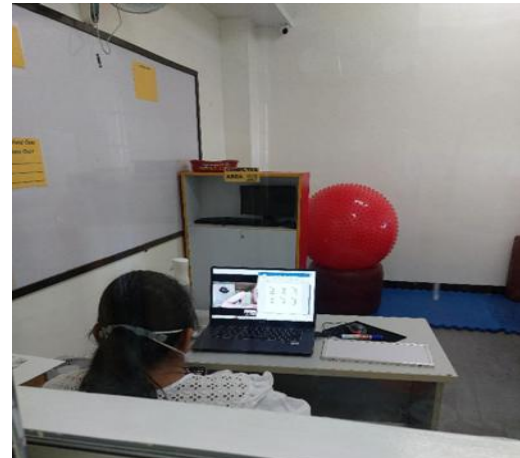
