# ONLINE HYBRID PROGRAM

The classes will be scheduled daily, Mondays to Fridays, with synchronous or face-to-face learning will be limited 3 times a week maximum, with two days offline studying. Kids World will prepare the schedules and enrolled students are expected to log in during the allotted times for their grade levels. See other options or get an appointment to discuss your choice.

Note: Should face-to-face classes be allowed, a slight adjustment will be made in the misc. fees

\*IEP – (Individual Education Plan) the cost will take the place of program modification for students in the regular classroom.

# ONLINE HYBRID PROGRAM

Other options:

1. Parents may choose to do full online three times a week, AND TWICE a week asynchronous;(same program as this year)
2. Parents may choose to do full online twice a week, twice a week asynchronous,one day ftf MAPEH
3. For other arrangements during transition period, please set appointment .

Note: Depending on agreed options, a slight adjustment may be made upon mutual agreement

\*IEP – (Individual Education Plan) the cost will take the place of program modification for students in the regular classroom.

# HOMEBASED ONLINE LEARNING (BLENDED)

This is for parents/families who have internet connection, but do not have the time to make study schedules, lesson plans, quizzes. (full online)

- The modality will be school-led with specific schedules for major subjects: math, English reading, English lang, Filipino, Aralin Panlipunan.
- Fixed Scheduled twice-weekly sessions with teachers, assessments, Parent Teacher Consultations.
- Our MAPEH teachers are specialist whose services were given free last year, will be added on this new school year.
- Added Learning Resources purchased and will be included in the adjustments.

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# HOMEBASED PROGRAM

other options

1. Parents may choose to do synchronous lessons twice a week, twice a week asynchronous, and come to school once a week for MAPEH and other Electives.
2. Face to face MAPEH AND ELECTIVES will be charged extra.  
(Parents may arrange with school on case to case basis)

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# HOMESCHOOL – PARENT LED

- Parents take full responsibility of their child's learning.
- Parents make own study schedule
- Parents pace speed according to their child's ability
- Parent teach their child using cur guide provided.
- Parents may choose to order books from KWIS or source their own
- Parents give test and quizzes
- The school will give summative assessment at end of school year (DepEd cycle)



# HOMESCHOOL PARENT-LED PROGRAM

1. Parents may chose to enroll in school (face to face) for MAPEH and/or electives. Additional fees will be charge

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# PARENT RESPONSIBILITIES AND OBLIGATIONS

For Parents who prefer face to face learning:

1. Waiver/consent form that you allow your child to come to school;
2. Frequency of school attendance until full face to face is feasible.
3. Child information as to vaccination/other health records which have not been submitted before
4. If you decide to allow your child to come to school—
  - a) does the child need a caregiver in campus?
  - b) Provide the school vaccination card or certification for both child and caregiver
    1. Provide personal health kit (soap, towel, disinfectant, small towel, change of clothing for emergency, toilet paper)
    2. Drop off and pick at the designated time (avoid further exposure while waiting)
